I am an exchange student from the Czech Republic and I would like to spend some time in Sweden. I lived in Sweden with my family for four years at the age of five, but then we returned back to Czechia. I have many nice memories and I also used to speak Swedish as well as can be expected of a 5 year old child. But unfortunately, I forgot most of it. The main reason for my choice was therefore, to get to know the country deeper and meet some new people, but mainly to learn Swedish if possible. I attend a high school, which focuses on German language, so I have 7 hours of German every week. Last year I was in Germany for one week as a part of an exchange program, which is organized by my school every year. I like learning new languages and I think I can already communicate pretty well in German after a short time of talking with someone. Therefore I also hope that it could be less difficult to get Swedish. Besides languages, history, geography, biology and arts are my favorite subjects. There is also a great sports area, which belongs to my school, where I also like to spend time so I often play games like football, basketball or frisbee with my friends during the breaks.
