Now I'm actually pretty excited to learn a new language and I already started learning it online. I live in a small town in Germany and really like that all my friends, the school and pretty much any place I go are within walking distance from my house. I also really like spending time with my friends - we have a really fun time at school. I like to hang out with them, have sleepovers, go shopping and we all go to the same dance class. Since I enjoy the time with my friends and family so much, I love birthday parties and one of my favorite traditions we have is Christmas. It's my mom's birthday, so we usually spend half the day celebrating that with her friends, and the other half celebrating Christmas, going to a church service and having dinner with our whole family. Another family tradition is going on a run at the beach, with my dad and my sister every Sunday morning. I enjoy that so much, because the view is gorgeous and I love the fresh air and - on most days - the running itself. I would describe myself as a generally pretty happy person, who is really curious about learning new things. My family describes me as a really caring person who doesn't mind doing chores for others or helping them wherever she can.

I also think that I am pretty ambitious, sometimes maybe a little too much. I set my goals high, but it does help me stay organised and achieve things, so I don't think it's necessarily a bad thing.

After school and work, which is tutoring little kids in an elementary school, I often like to visit my friends to hangout with them, go on walks with their dogs.
